As spring approaches, it is nearly time for our 2009 annual monitoring visit to your conservation easement property. Thank you, landowner name, for walking with us last year and we welcome your presence on the upcoming monitoring visit, but it is not mandatory that you be along. If you desire to accompany us, please mark the box on the enclosed landowner questionnaire. We will then be in contact with you by telephone to establish a date for the visit. If you don't care to come along, we'll be in contact by telephone at least two weeks prior to our intended visit to be sure the date is acceptable.

We ask that you take a moment to fill out the rest of the questionnaire and return it to SAHC in the enclosed, self-addressed, stamped envelope. These questions are designed to allow you to notify us of any anticipated changes in land ownership within the coming year (such as a sale, transfer or lease), or of any planned building or landscape alterations on your property. Depending on the terms of your easement, certain activities (such as subdivision, residential construction, or timber harvesting) may require prior notice to, and/or approval by, SAHC.

As always, feel free to contact us about details of your easement or other land management issues on your property; we will do our best to answer any questions or to put you in contact with a specialist.

Thank you for your continued commitment to land conservation and we look forward to visiting your property again this spring.
