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THE "SALAD" YEARS . . .



-Land Trust has acquired Fee Title or Easement

-Landowner has cash from sale or tax advantages

-Landowner motivated by conservation has land conserved

BUT, IT'S A LONG ROAD . . .

Subsequent owners may not be as motivated by conservation!

PUT IT IN WRITING – ALWAYS!

ARTICLE III. ENFORCEMENT AND REMEDIES

A. Notification and Enforcement. To accomplish the objectives of this Conservation Easement, the parties are allowed to prevent any activity on or use of the Property that is inconsistent with the purposes of this Conservation Easement and to require the restoration of such areas or features of the Property that may be damaged by such activity or use. Upon any breach of the terms of this Conservation Easement by either party (the "Breaching Party") that comes to the attention of the other party ("Non-Breaching Party"), the Non-Breaching Party shall notify the Breaching Party in writing of such breach and whether it considers such breach to be material. The Breaching Party shall have ninety (90) days after receipt of such notice to correct the conditions constituting such breach. If a breach alleged to be a material breach by the other party remains uncured after ninety (90) days, the Non-Breaching Party may . . . Rayburn Agricultural

- -Litigate Only if Necessary, but . . .






