- Not intended to guide or direct motorists
- Erect at or near, but outside of NCDOT right of way
- Permission from private property
- NCDOT will not locate signs
- May include on special city/county limit signs

### Sign Installations

- If inside the clear zone, supports must be yielding or on a breakaway device
- Do not place posts in a ditch or drainage channel
- Clear of vegetation sight angle
- Aluminum signs last longer
- ~\$250 per sign installation
- Signs installed by others



## State of North Carolina Department of Transportation



#### Maintenance

- NCDOT reserves the right to remove any signs that:
  - Resemble a traffic control device
  - Use misleading messages
  - Block the view of official DOT signs
- Signs can be fabricated by public or private source
