COST SHARE PROGRAM ON-FARM ANAEROBIC DIGESTERS

ABOUT OUR PROGRAM

The NC Foundation for Soil and Water Conservation, North Carolina Department of Agriculture & Consumer Services, and Align RNG (a joint venture between Dominion Energy and Smithfield Foods, Inc.) is offering a cost share program to support the installation of anaerobic digesters on swine farms in Sampson & Duplin counties.

PROGRAM GUIDELINES

- Farm must be located in Sampson or Duplin county
- Farm design capacity of less than one million (1,000,000) pounds of steady state live weight
- Applicant will enter into a multi-year binding contract with Align RNG
- Maximum cost share is the lesser of \$100,000 or 75% of actual construction costs that exceed \$440 per 1,000 pounds of steady state live weight

APPLICATION PROCESS

The application is a two-step process: (1) Pre-screening for eligibility, and (2) Full application (after eligibility has been verified via pre-screening).

Application does not guarantee cost share approval. **The Screening Application and Instructions can be downloaded from the website below.**

Applications are accepted on a rolling basis.
