ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Applicant accepts the following eligibility requirements and, through submission of this Screening Application, represents and warrants that it satisfies such requirements:

- Applicant has received a Letter of Interest from Align, and has included the Letter of Interest as an attachment with this Screening Application.
- Applicant hereby certifies that it is in compliance with all laws, regulations, zoning requirements, or other federal, state, and local governmental rules, and has no unpaid taxes, penalties or judgments outstanding.
- Applicant and its proposed swine biogas equipment must be located within the State of North Carolina.
- Applicant must have a design capacity of less than one million (1,000,000) pounds of steady state live weight.
- Applicant must enter into a contract with Align with a duration of ten (10) years or more for the purchase by Align of the biogas produced by the anaerobic digester.
- If Applicant leases the premises on which the Business or Farm is situated (the "*Premises*"), there is a minimum of ten (10) years remaining in the term of the lease, and the lease will not expire prior to the expiration of the biogas contract with Align.
- The maximum amount of cost-share that Applicant may ultimately receive (subject the sole and absolute discretion of Program Sponsors) is the lesser of (a) One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) or (b) seventy-five percent (75%) of the portion of actual construction and equipment costs of the biogas equipment that exceed Four Hundred Forty Dollars (\$440.00) per thousand (1,000) pounds of steady state live weight.
